Eligibility

Parking at North Central is determined by where you will live during the school year and your class status (freshman, transfer, re-applicant). Parking is limited on North Central's campus. Therefore, not everyone is guaranteed to receive parking.

Residence Hall Students

Freshman

Parking is limited on North Central's campus. Therefore, not everyone is guaranteed to receive parking. Freshman may apply online for parking, but priority is given to those students above freshman level status. Parking is assigned on a first come first served basis.

A nearby off-campus parking option is available for students who are unable to receive parking through North Central University.

Imperial Parking- 7th St & 10th Ave (Metrodome Square Ramp/Staff and faculty ramp)

Transfer & Re-Applicants

Students are eligible to apply online for on-campus parking at the rate of \$250/semester.

Campus Apartment Residents (Orfield, Elliot East, Mensing)

On-Campus Parking

Orfield Apartment: Students can apply for on-campus parking in North Central lots at the rate of \$250/semester or the Metrodome Square Ramp at the rate of \$265/semester.

Elliot East Apartment: Students receive 1 parking space per apartment included with their rent. Additional students can apply for on-campus parking in North Central lots at the rate of \$250/semester or in the Metrodome Square Ramp.

Mensing Hall: Students are eligible to park in the Metrodome Square Ramp at the rate of \$265/semester.

Street Parking

Parking on the streets around campus has a 2 hour limit. However, as residents of the Elliot Park neighborhood, North Central students who live in the apartments are eligible for a Critical Parking Permit from the City of Minneapolis which allows them to park on the street at all times. Since a limited number of street parking permits are given to North Central, you must apply for street parking as soon as possible. Students who receive street parking will receive a "Residency Verification Slip" from the Security Office when they arrive on campus and then file for this permit at the Minneapolis City Hall. Cost is \$25/year.

Commuters

On-Campus Parking

Parking is available in the commuter lots (15th & Chicago lot or Zimmerman lot). There are 60 parking spots in these lots - **you are not guaranteed a spot each day as they are first-come first-serve parking with more commuters than there are spaces available.** The cost is \$30 per semester and you must have a commuter parking sticker to park in these lots.

Note: Commuter lots will be closed on special event days (approximately 15 days throughout year). Daily parking is available in several area parking lots. These lots charge from \$3-\$5 each day. A complete list of these parking lots is on our website at www.northcentral.edu/security.

Parking at North Central is limited due to a limitation placed on street parking permits by the City of Minneapolis and enrollment growth. We are exploring additional parking opportunities to alleviate this problem in the future. We appreciate your understanding and patience as we grow.
