Course	Requirements	Examples
Communications (2 credits)	Any Communications related course. <i>*Ministry majors must take Public Speaking.</i>	Public Speaking, Intro to Communication
Fine Arts (2 credits)	Any Fine Arts course relating to art, music, theater, or film.	Intro to Art or Music, Drawing, Pottery, Band
Foundations of Leadership (1 credit)	Must include aspects of servant leadership. A course <i>only</i> pertaining to college orientation is not sufficient.	Introduction to College (from another Christian university.)
Global Perspectives (3 credits)	Any Global Perspective related course.	Global Awareness, Evangelism and Missions
History (3 credits)	Any History related course. <i>*Elementary Ed majors must take American History.</i>	American History, Government,
English (9 credits)	Any English, Writing, or Literature courses. One course must include research writing with an 8-10 pg. research paper. <i>*Does not include Children's/Adolescent literature.</i>	Composition I & II, Research Writing, Shakespeare
Physical Education (2 credits)	At least 1 of the 2 credits must be an activity related course; both can be activity related.	Fitness for Life, Nutrition, CPR
Math (3 credits)	Must be a college level course. A developmental course is not sufficient. <i>*Business, Psychology & Education majors must take College Algebra.</i>	Math for Liberal Arts, College Algebra, Calculus
Science (3 credits)	Any Science related course. Does not have to include a lab. <i>*Elementary Ed majors must take Physical Science by Inquiry at NCU.</i>	Biology, Astronomy, Chemistry
Critical Thought (3 credits)	Any Critical Thought related course.	Philosophy, Ethics, Ethics in Professions, Political Science
Psychology (3 credits)	Any Psychology related course. <i>*Psychology and Education majors must take General Psychology.</i>	General Psychology, Lifespan Development
Sociology or Cultural Anthropology (3 credits)	Any Sociology or Anthropology related course. <i>*Elementary Ed majors must take Intro to Sociology</i> <i>*Intercultural Studies majors must take Cultural Anthropology.</i>	Intro to Sociology, Society and Values, Anthropology

Course	Requirements	Examples
Old Testament History and Literature (3 credits)	Must cover the entire Old Testament from a historical viewpoint. Can be taken at a secular institution.	Old Testament Survey
New Testament History (3 credits)	Must cover the entire New Testament from a historical viewpoint. Can be taken at a secular institution.	New Testament Survey
Bible Study Methods (3 credits)	Must include learning various methods of studying the Bible and an exegesis paper.	Intro to Biblical Interpretation
Spiritual Formation (3 credits)	Must include the importance of prayer, a devotional life, and evangelism. Can be taken at any Christian university.	Essential Christianity
Systematic Theology I (3 credits)	Must include Assembly of God theology and the 16 Tenets of Faith.	Assembly of God Doctrine and Theology, Intro to Christian Doctrine
Systematic Theology III (3 credits)	Must include Soteriology, Christology, regeneration, justification, sanctification, and adoption.	
Old Testament Elective (3 credits)	Any Old Testament related course.	Pentateuch, Minor Prophets, Jeremiah
New Testament Elective (3 credits)	Any New Testament related course.	Romans, Synoptic Gospels
Bible Elective (3 credits)	Any Bible related elective.	Archaeology, Bible Geography
Acts or Pentecostal Distinctives (3 credits)	Must include the history of Pentecostal heritage or the study of the book of Acts.	Pentecostal Foundations (3 credits)
