Science (3 credits)	Choose One: Any Science course <i>*Elementary Ed. majors must take Physical Science @ NCU. *Psychology majors must take a biological science.</i>
Critical Thought (3 credits)	Choose One: PHI 101-110 <i>*Carlstrom Deaf Studies majors must take CDS 275 Ethics & Decision Making for Interpreters.</i>
Social Relations (6 credits)	PSY 111 - Introduction to Psychology –and– Choose One: ANT 105 Cultural Anthropology SOC 110 - Introduction to Sociology <i>*Intercultural Studies majors must take ANT 105. *Youth Development Studies majors must take SOCL 1401.</i>
