What furniture does my room & suite contain?

Room

2 bed frames with long twin-sized mattresses

2 dressers 2 desks and 2 chairs

closet space voicemail (phone, ethernet and antenna jacks)

window blinds garbage can (you'll need to purchase bags)

Suite (may vary based on size of suite)

1 couch 1 upholstered chair (6 and 8 person only)
1 end table 1 coffee table (6 and 8 person only)
1-2 lamps 2 occasional chairs (only 1 in 4 person)

Furniture provided by the University CANNOT be removed from the room/suite or exchanged with furniture from other rooms, suites, or lounges.

Disallowed items:

The following items are **not** allowed in your room/suite:

No upholstered furniture (couches or reclining chairs)

Cinder blocks or bricks Firearms, fireworks, explosives, or any sort of weapons

Space heaters Oil popcorn poppers

Toasters/toaster ovens Electric skillets/George Forman Grills
Halogen lamps Burnt candles or candle warmers

Hot plates Live Christmas greenery

Loft Kits Video games, TV, or movies with ratings of Adult Only, R, TVMA or higher

Allowed items:

The following items are allowed in your room/suite:

coffee maker air popcorn poppers hot pot water heater sandwich makers

bread maker desk lamp (no halogen lamps)

small microwave (1 per 2 people) refrigerator (1 per 2 people; under five cubic feet in capacity)

RD approved bed risers

Can I decorate my room?

Absolutely! You are allowed to rearrange your room and suite (no lofting of beds) and to decorate to reflect your personality! Be sure to talk with your roommate/suitemates to come up with a decorating plan. Also—please read the following guidelines for hanging items/decorating your dorm room:

DO NOT USE: NAILS, TACKS, TAPE, 3M, or SCREWS

Use sticky tack to hang decorations/posters

Use supplied cork strips for hanging heavier items with tacks.

All in-room furniture is stackable with the exception of stacking beds on top of desk/dressers/shelves.

If you would like to bunk, un-bunk, or otherwise adjust your beds, please ask your RA for a rubber mallet

<u>DO NOT put the bed spring on the top notch.</u> The frames crack easily and injury may occur. You will be charged for damage to your bed if it is not stacked properly.

- *Cleaning and stocking the bathroom with toilet paper is your responsibility.
- *Please clean your bathroom/shower area on a regular basis. Your RA will do inspections on a regular basis.
- *Residents of Phillipps should be cautious of sprinkler heads when arranging their room/suite. Any damage resulting from a discharged sprinkler is the financial responsibility of the one who set it off.
