The Mathematics Major Tuition Scholarship is a \$2500 annual tuition scholarship renewable for up to eight semesters. The scholarship is awarded to first-time freshmen students each year based on superior academic performance, a written essay, and two references. Eligible students must meet all of the following criteria at the time of application:

Minimum ACT Composite Score of 28, and a Math score of 28 <u>or</u>, A minimum SAT Total Score of 1240, and a Math score of 620*

And a minimum 3.3 High School GPA

*The composite score for either ACT or SAT excludes the optional writing portion of the exam.

The scholarship recipient must be accepted to North Central University in order to be eligible to apply for this scholarship. In addition, the recipient must enroll in the Fall 2017 semester or the scholarship will be forfeited. All scholarship applicants will be sent written notification of the Mathematics Scholarship Award Committee's decision by February 1, 2018.
