IRS Data Retrieval Tool Information

Reasons you would **not** be eligible for the IRS Data Retrieval Tool:

- The student/parent is married, and either the student/parent or his/her spouse filed as Married Filing Separately.
- The student/parent is married, and either the student/parent or his/her spouse filed as Head of Household.
- The parents' marital status is "Unmarried and both legal parents living together."
- The student/parent filed a Puerto Rican foreign tax return.

If you are unable to use the Data Retrieval Tool, please see the next page for directions to request a tax return transcript.

How to use the Data Retrieval Tool:

- 1. If you have already submitted a FAFSA and are going back in to use the Data Retrieval Tool, log back into your already submitted FAFSA using your FSA ID and password. Click "Make a Correction" and go to the "Financial Information" section.
- 2. There will be a series of questions:
 - a. For 2022, have you completed your IRS income tax return or another tax return? **Select: Already Completed.**
 - b. What income tax return did you file for 2022? Select: IRS Form 1040
 - c. For 2022, what is your tax filing status according to your tax return? Select how you filed.
 - d. The FAFSA should present an option to transfer your tax information with the Data Retrieval Tool. Click "Proceed to IRS."
- 3. Click "Proceed to IRS" again to connect to the IRS website.
- 4. On the IRS website, enter the requested information **EXACTLY** as it appears on your 2022 tax return. If you get an error that there's no match, double check your information, including the exact mailing address on your return. Click "Submit."
- 5. Click "Transfer my tax information into the FAFSA," and then click "Transfer Now."
- 6. If you made a correction on an already submitted FAFSA, make sure to resubmit your FAFSA at the end.

Please allow 2-3 days for the Financial Aid Office to receive your submitted or resubmitted FAFSA. If you use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, you will not need to request an IRS tax return transcript.

- You will receive them in 5-10 calendar days at the address the IRS has on file for you.
